Suffolk Wildlife Trust is an inspiring and impactful organisation with a compelling vision for our county:

A Wilder Suffolk where nature is thriving and abundant, because everyone is doing more to help.

In the decade to 2030 we are committed to scaling up our activities across the county to bring nature back to Suffolk. Our aim is for 30% of our county to be connected and well looked after for nature by 2030, so that our species and habitats can recover and thrive - and for 1 in 4 people to be actively helping to achieve this. Every member of staff has a direct role to play in our mission to **Bring nature back**.

Visitor Experience & Engagement is one of the ways in which we help people play their part and foster stronger connections to nature.

Carlton Marshes on the western fringe of Lowestoft is a magnificent water-filled landscape. Our work here, supported by the National Lottery Heritage Fund, is transforming the southern borders of the UK's most nature-rich areas into a spectacular year-round destination for nature-based recreation, learning and play - a gateway to the Broads National Park that local people are proud of.

Unparalleled opportunities to get close-up to wildlife, brought to life by a landmark visitor centre, makes Carlton one of the most accessible nature experiences in East Anglia.





Role description – what you will do

We are looking for a team player with excellent people skills to be visitor facing as a 'Welcome Host' on a daily basis. Every staff role has three key areas of focus to support our mission to bring nature back. Typically, you will spend 80% of your time on these:

1 – VISITOR EXPERIENCE

- Ensure a welcoming, high-quality, memorable and consistent visitor experience for a range of audiences at Carlton Marshes .
- Proactively interact with visitors providing excellent customer service.
- Responsibility for setting up an inviting and engaging 'Welcome' area
- Ensure all areas of Carlton Marshes are well-maintained, clean and tidy, including assisting with day-to-day manging and problem solving.
- Respond to visitor enquiries in person, by phone and email
- Provide focused, hands-on support and training to visitor centre volunteers, ensuring they are well informed to provide an excellent visitor experience
- Undertaking occasional cleaning, as required

2 –INCOME GENERATION

- Work with the Engagement Manager and Head of Business Development to assist in meeting the site's retail income targets through monitoring stock levels, ordering products, facilitating retail stock takes, and visual merchandising.
- Coordinate and support volunteers in their roles within retail, welcome and wildlife guiding.
- Build and increase Trust membership by recruiting members face to face & supporting a membership culture that empowers volunteers to drive recruitment.
- Actively promote and coordinate venue hire for Carlton Marsh's Discovery Room.



Role description and the approach you need

3 – ENGAGEMENT

- Facilitate engagement opportunities (drop in and bookable) for children, young people, adults and families at Carlton Marshes at weekends, including bank holidays and evenings and throughout the school holidays
- Facilitate Wild Walk opportunities delivered externally and internally
- Embrace an audience-led approach to developing new opportunities to experience and learn about nature and to ensuring that the opportunities we enable are relevant, meaningful and accessible
- Report on engagement activity and undertake additional quantitative and qualitative evaluation, as agreed with Engagement Manager
- Signpost visitors to further opportunities to engage with and support the Trust, including events and activities at Carlton Marshes and across the county, other Trust reserves to visit and volunteering opportunities
- Create inspiring social media content to share stories, promote and celebrate engagement opportunities at Carlton Marshes and the reserve as a destination
